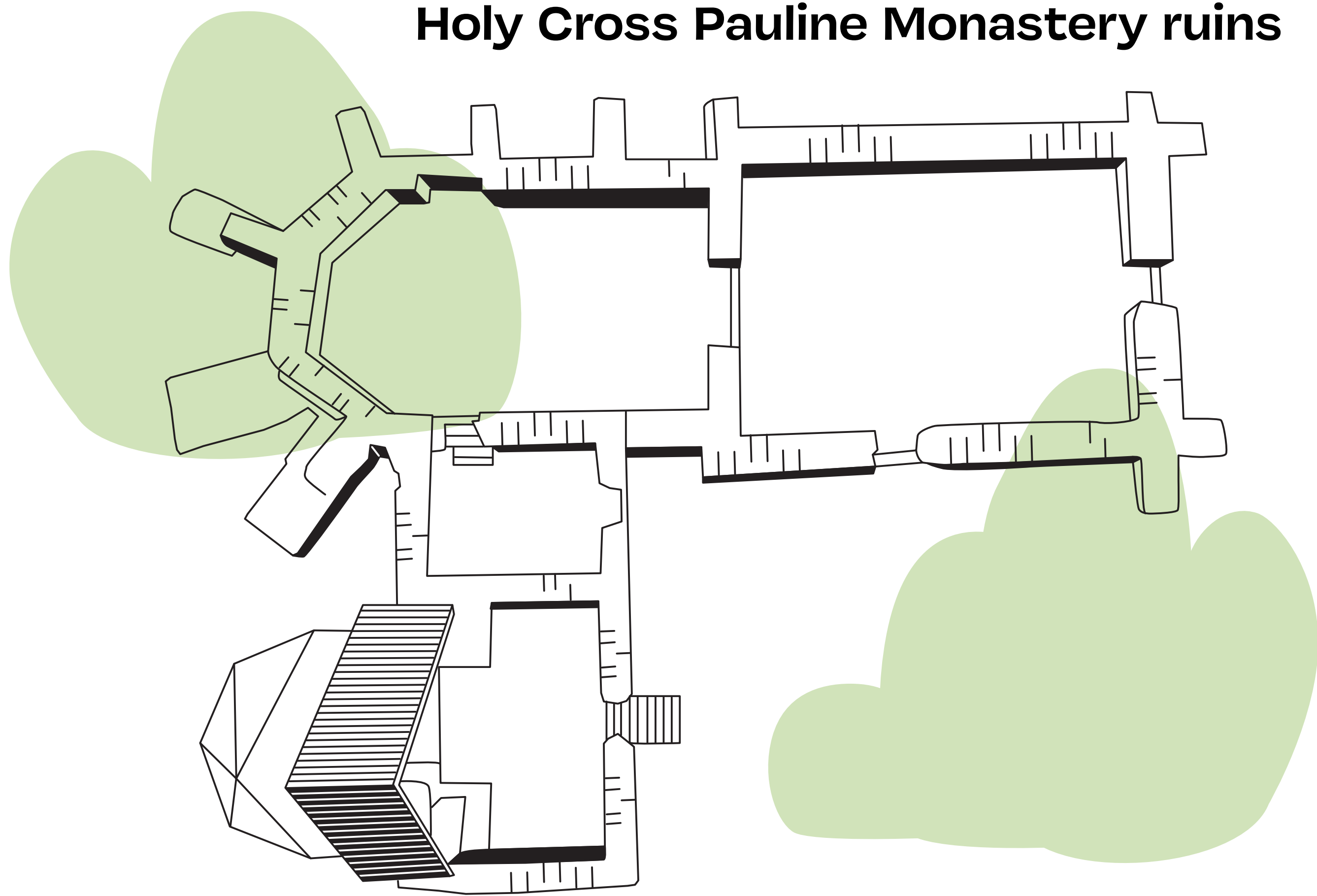


Cycling team building in the Pilis

You can roam the most beautiful landscapes of the Pilis in two days, but due to the forest terrain, the tour is recommended mainly for experienced cyclists. Every now and then, it's worth swapping your bike for hiking boots to explore the peaks, caves and gorges of Pilis.

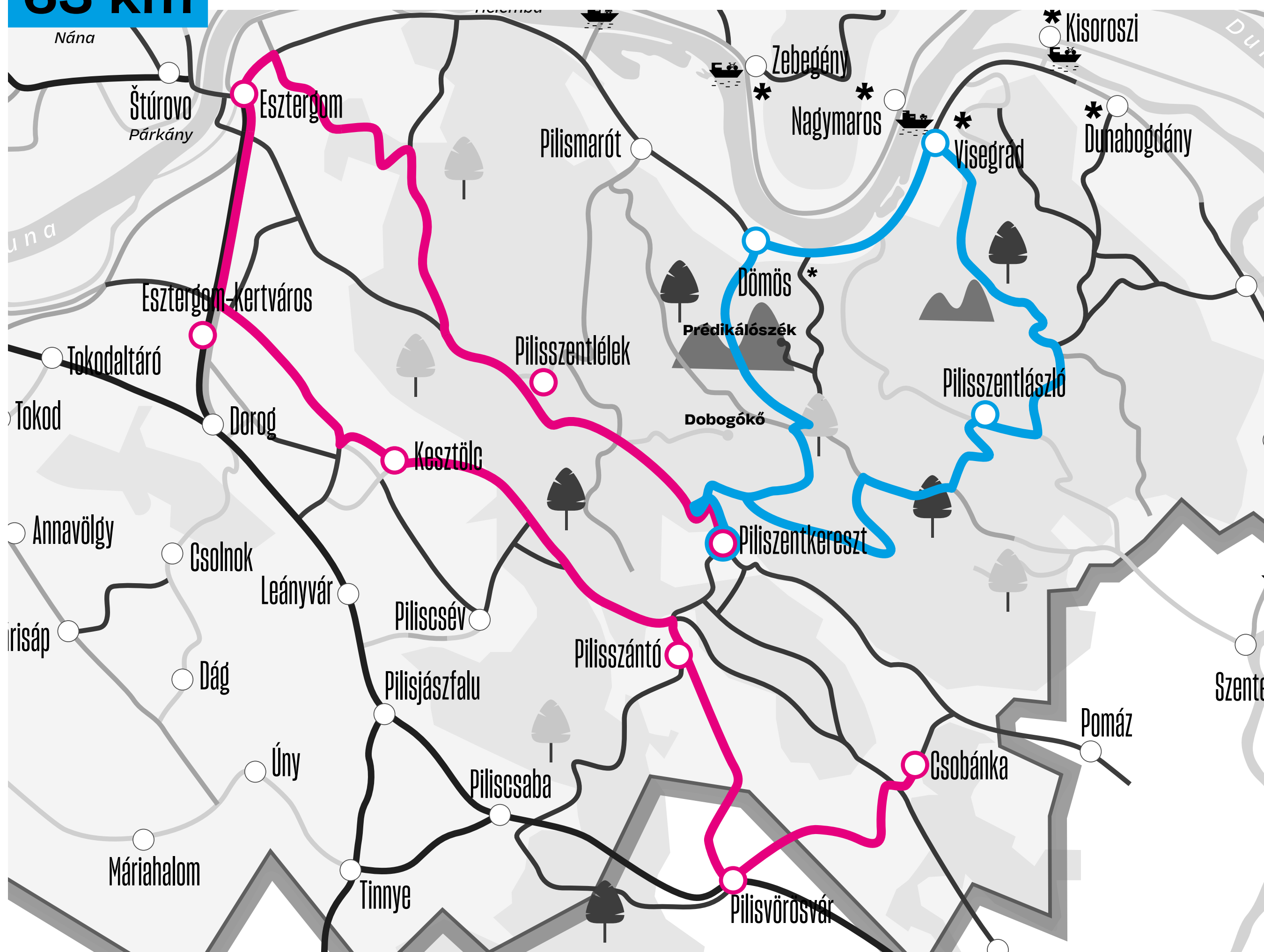

Which roads can you cycle on?

Part of the two-day tour is on Pilis Bike's forest cycle paths, but you will also have to use small and medium traffic roads.

TOP 5 attractions

The Mackó („Teddy”) cave in Csobánka

The Mackó Cave – officially known as the Kis Kevélyi Cave – is one of the most famous caves in the Pilis, where numerous paleontological and archaeological findings have been unearthed, including animal bones, cracked stone tools, blades and utensils. The 65-metre long cave is open to the public and is a popular excursion site.

Pilisvörösvár

Pilisvörösvár is one of the most beautiful Swabian settlements in Hungary. The first Swabian farmers arrived in the late 17th century and are commemorated by a group of statues on the corner of Iskola Street and Church Square. The town's local history collection, housed in an old farmhouse, is also worth a visit, as is the park dedicated to the town's former miners.

Esztergom - Iron Gate Hill

Once you've had a long walk around the centre of Esztergom, visited the Basilica and the Christian Museum, head for Vaskapu Hill, whose 404-metre-high peak is a popular hiking spot. At the top of Vaskapu Hill you'll find a shelter built in 1914, and not far away you can admire a statue of the Virgin Mary. And of course, don't forget the breathtaking panorama!

Dömös Monastery

One of the most unique villages in the Danube Bend is Dömös, famous for more than just the Rám Gorge. It was here that the brother of King Kálmán the Elder, Prince Álmos, founded a monastery in the early 12th century. Today, you can only see the foundations of the former royal castle and the monastery building, but the church is still in good condition and is an ecumenical place of prayer.

The Zsitvay Lookout in Visegrád

The Zsitvay Lookout, built in 1933, sits on top of the 378-metre-high Great Hill, and on a clear day you can see up to 100 kilometres away. The Nagy Villám also has surprises in store for sports lovers: on the 700-metre-long bobsleigh track, which winds along the south side of the mountain, you can try both alpine and summer bobsleigh, or even perfect your downhill skiing technique at the ski school.

+1 tip

Try traditional Swabian dishes – such as Swabian meat soup with dumplings or oven-baked roast leg – at the Stube restaurant in Pilisvörösvár.

Forgalmas főút, nagy sebességgelhasználják az autók.
Bár nem tiltott a kerékpározás rajta, de erősen javasolt az elkerülése.

Rušná hlavná cesta, po ktorej jazdia autá vysokou rýchlosťou.
Hoci jazda na bicykli nie je zakázaná, dôrazne sa odporúča vyhnúť sa jej.
Busy main road, used by cars at high speed. Although cycling is not prohibited, it is strongly advised to avoid it.



Forgalmas fő út, nagy sebességgel használják az autók.
Használata csak hétvégén javasolt.

Rušná hlavná cesta, po ktorej jazdia autá vysokou rýchlosťou.
Cyklisti by sa jej mali radšej vyhnúť, najmä počas pracovných dní.
*Busy main road, used by cars at high speed.
Preferably avoided by cyclists, especially on weekdays.*



Közepes forgalmú főút, gyakorlott kerékpárosoknak javasolt csak.
Stredne frekventovaná hlavná cesta, odporúčaná len pre skúsených cyklistov.
Medium traffic main road, recommended for experienced cyclists only.



Kisebb forgalmú főút, kerékpározásra is kedvező.
Menej frekventovaná hlavná cesta, priaznivá aj pre cyklistov.
A less busy main road, also favourable for cycling.



Kis forgalmú mellékút, kedvező bringás túraút lehet.
Je to vedľajšia cesta s malou premávkou a môže byť výhodnou cyklotrasou.
It is a minor road with little traffic and can be a favourable cycling route.



Forgalomtól elválasztott kerékpárút.
Oddelená cyklistická cesta.
Bicycle path separated from traffic.



Forgalomtól elzárt út, kerékpározás megengedett.
Cesta uzavretá pre dopravu, jazda na bicykli povolená.
Road closed to traffic, cycling allowed.



Nem szilárd útvonalú út, kerékpározható, ballonosabb gumijú bringán.
Nespevnená cesta, prejazdná na bicykli s balónovitými pneumatikami.
Unsurfaced road, cycleable, on a bicycle with a more balloon-shaped tyre.
